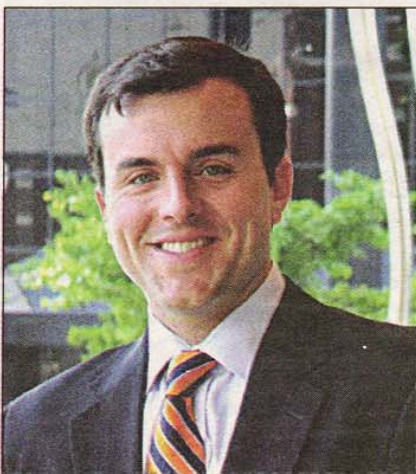
College: Dartmouth College, '02; Washington University, '09

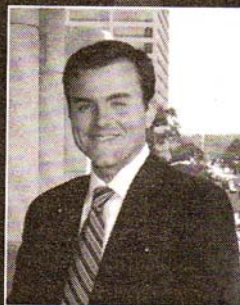
